First- Cohokia- facts about them

- One of the first cities in North America (built around 700)
- Farmers, (corn) not hunters and gatherers.
- Located at the center of trade routes — became traders

Eastern Woodlands

- food from the forest— United People
- Iroquois- Iroquois league- government was run — might have influenced the founders of our own government
- *How are the people being innovative.- creating new things*

The Plains and Pueblos

Lakota and Comanche

- Used buffalo as a resource- lived in the Northern part of the Plains.
- Comanche- traded clothing and tools for fresh food.

People of the Southwest

- Ancestral Pueblo- left these communities around 1300.
- Pueblo and other Native Americans learned to farm in a hot dry land, they grew vegetables. The Apache moved following Buffalo.

Why did the Lakota live in teepees?

The West

West is a large region with eleven states.

Adapted to surroundings— lived in mountains, along the coast and the desert. Hunted and gathered- Northwest coast OR- Alaska

Region of Plenty

- Tlingit went to the sea for food.
- Developed technology
- Large canoes
- Trade with other peoples.

Great Basin- used resources (Shoshone)
